The FCC’s [Report and Order](#) in August 2011 implements the “educating” requirements of the law; saying that schools must provide for educating minors about appropriate online behavior, including interacting with other individuals on social networking websites and in chat rooms and cyber bullying awareness and response. Budget-strapped districts need a solution that:

- ▶ **satisfies CIPA education requirements,**
- ▶ **documents schools’ e-Safety policy education, and**
- ▶ **is affordable!**

Are There Other E-Rate Compliance Options?
